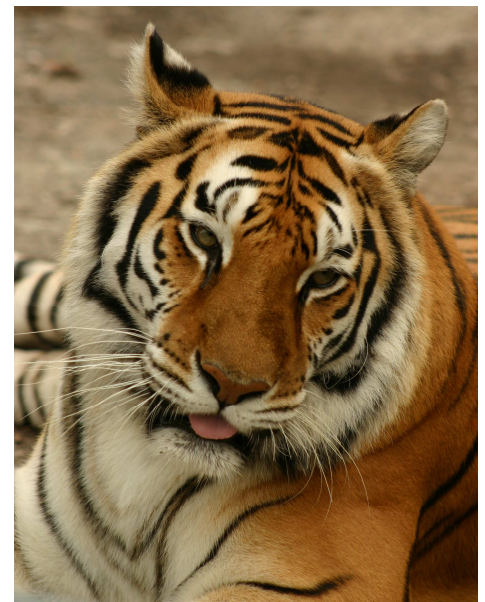


Wildlife Survival Sanctuary is managed by Jim Moore and Suzan. Many volunteers bring their help throughout the year to prepare the meals for animals.

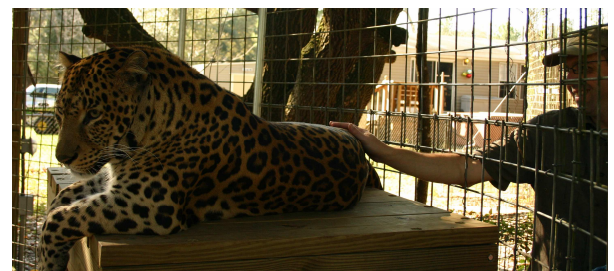
in some states, it is possible to obtain a license to own wild animals at his home in cages woefully inadequate in size to the size of the animal (imagine a tiger in a cage of about 10m²).

Tigers, leopards, servals and cougars are animals collected by Jim and Susan in different conditions. The most common case is when owners buy an animal on impulse and then are unable to take care of it and to meet his nutritional needs. Indeed, the meals of felines in captivity must be balanced and adapted to the little exercise they do in their cages.

In this refuge with large cages, Jim and Susan also recover feline victims of profit-oriented crossings which have failed. (Ex: white tigers sold to circuses). Fortunately there are also very healthy animals brought by the owners because they are too old to look after them.
