Conservation actions in the environment are conducted in Europe and around the world, in partnership with other NGOs.

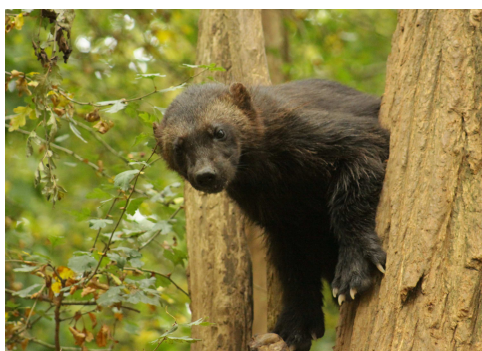
The reserve welcomes volunteers all the year.

Species in the reserve are grouped by geographic area:

- **Europe:** Wolverine, Mink, Souslik, rock hyrax, Ferruginous Duck, Bald Ibis, Barn Owl.
- **Madagascar:** Lemur (Catta, Crowned, Black and white Vari,...), Fossa, Teal Bernier, Duck Meller.
- **South America:** Wolf maned, white Marmoset Brush, Margay, Saki, Geoffroy's Marmoset, Tapir Earth, Southern Screamer necklace, Capybara, Squirrel Monkey, Goeldi's Tamarin, Poudou Andes.
- **Oceania:** Parma Wallaby, Goura Victoria, Potorou.
